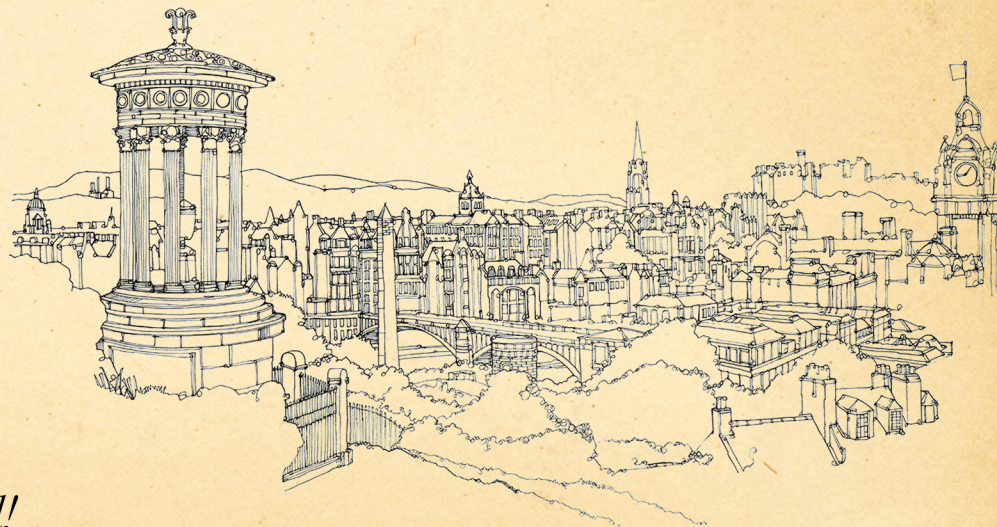
Friday, July 24th

Saturday, July 25th

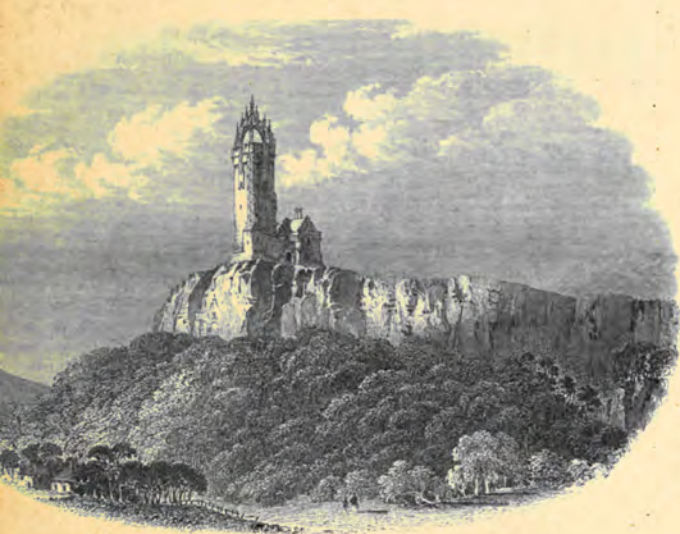
We will also take a hour long cruise on Loch Lomond, one of the prettiest and largest lochs in the whole of Scotland.

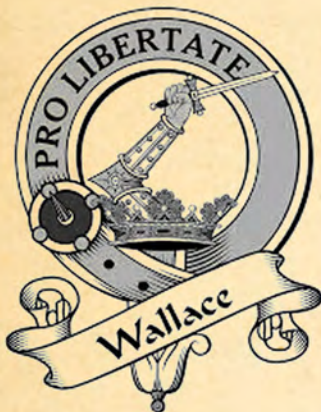

Travel Tips

Time - Great Britain sets its clocks by Greenwich Mean Time, five hours ahead of the U.S. East Coast.

Tipping- Tipping is done in Scotland as in the United States, but at a lower level. Some restaurants include a service charge on the bill; if not, add about 10% to 15%. Taxi drivers, hairdressers, and barbers should also get 10% to 15%.

Electricity- The electrical current in Scotland, as in the rest of Great Britain, is 220-240 volts (in line with the rest of Europe)

Money- Britain's monetary system is based on the pound Sterling (£), which is made up of 100 pence (written as "p"). Britons also call pounds "quid." It is subject to change, but as of now the exchange rate reads that every \$1.56 USD = £1 British Pound

Weather- An average summer day in Scotland will be around 67 degrees. But there is no telling what kind of weather we will have. A cool summer day could be anywhere from 50-60 degrees and a hot summer day could hit 70-80 degrees. And always be prepared for rain!



Directions

Edinburgh Airport to Edinburgh City Hotel

From Edinburgh Airport follow A8 to Princess Street turn onto A702 at Lothian Road, drive straight through five sets of traffic lights and take the third left turning into Lauriston Place



Edinburgh International Airport is 8 miles west of the city, a taxi service operates from the airport and the approximate cost to the hotel is £14.00. A shuttle bus service also operates every 15 minutes to and from Waverley bridge. There is also a tram that operates every 10 minutes, costs £5 per adult. You can take that to the West End-Princes St. stop and its a 5 minute walk. Make a left onto Lothian Rd. and a left on to Lauriston Place and the hotel is on your right.

Edinburgh City Center to Dundas Castle

If travelling from the centre of Edinburgh, the best route to take is along Queensferry Road and on the A90, towards the Forth Road Bridge. At Echline Junction (the last slip road before the Bridge) take the road up to the roundabout. Turn right at the third exit on to the B800. Head straight over the next roundabout. The entrance to the Castle is on the right 300 metres after leaving the roundabout (and past the flyover) there are signs by the Main gate.



Edinburgh Airport to Dundas Castle

If travelling from Edinburgh Airport, exit the airport, take the A8 heading towards the Forth Road Bridge (right at the second roundabout). This road will take you to the 'Newbridge roundabout'. Now take the M9 towards Stirling. In approximately 1 mile take the slip road sign posted Forth Road Bridge. Travel on the M9 which will then take you onto the A90. At the Echline Junction (the last slip road before the Bridge) take the road up to the roundabout. Turn right at the
